Fr. James Michael Bevacqua, dearly known as Fr. Jim, led the October 29th Ribbon-cutting ceremony with retired Bishop Gerald Wilkerson's blessing of the Grade School's enhanced facility renovations. Esteemed guests of honor John and Dorothy Shea of Shea Family Charities, dignitaries from the City of Glendale and the Department of Catholic Schools, Archdiocese of Los Angeles were in attendance. Thanks to the gifts of the Shea Family Charities to implement the second phase of a master plan which is the renovation of the Grade School fence and play yard. Fr. 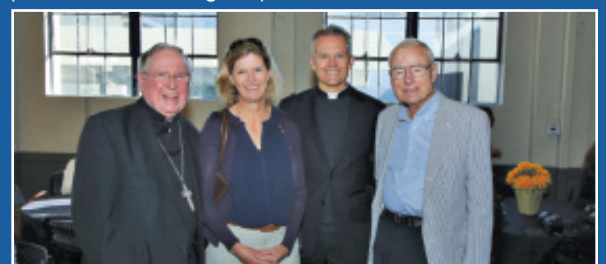
