
1. Pick up of 1st Academic Quarter Report Cards and STAR Test Results.

How to Create a Handbid Account for Participation in PCF, Parish Country Fair



Bidders can create a Handbid account from either the Handbid website or from the mobile app on their smartphone.

NOTE: Users must download the app before the login link will work.

Our auction will be in PRESALE, PREVIEW or OPEN status before having bidders sign up.

On the Handbid Website

1. Go to the Handbid Events website: <https://events.handbid.com>
2. Click the **LOGIN** in the menu on the top right.
3. Select the **CREATE ACCOUNT** in the bottom right of the login screen. You will be prompted to enter the following information: first and last name, email address, passphrase, and your cell number. *A passphrase is used in place of a password. There are no special characters required and they are typically more secure. Use something like "I luv rock and roll". We find these easier for users to remember.*
4. You will be asked to agree to terms and conditions.
5. Once complete you will have a Handbid account. From here, go to the main search bar on the events site and search for the event you intend to bid in.
6. Find that event in the dropdown list and click on it to view that event's home page. Once on the event homepage, it will either prompt you to register, or you can click on the BUY TICKETS or REGISTER menu options to get registered.
7. Once registered, you want to bid from your smartphone, you will receive a text message with your Handbid PIN code and a link to login to the app. (NOTE: You must download the Handbid app before this link will work)

On the Mobile App

1. Download the Handbid app from the App Store or Google Play Store (**NOTE: THIS APP IS ALWAYS FREE**)
2. Enter your First Name, Last Name, Email, and Cell Phone Number. Click **NEXT**. (Note: The cell phone number entered above must be allowed to receive text messages)
3. You will receive a text message to the cell phone number entered on the first screen. This text will contain a 5 digit pin code.
4. Enter the five digit pin code and Handbid will log you into the app.
5. Select your auction from the list and TAP REGISTER (vs. Browse) to register for an auction and get a Paddle ID assigned.

Event Title: **Holy Family-Glendale Virtual Parish Country Fair**

Our Parish Country Fair Online Bidding event **started yesterday**, Saturday, October 17th and will be on-going until Sunday, the 25th.

STEPS TO FOLLOW:

1. Download the Handbid App to become part of the Virtual PCF Event. Once you're in, you can select the login link.
2. Register as a bidder and put a card on file.
3. Adding a credit card is secure and the CC information is not stored (or accessible) by the organization or Handbid. It is stored directly with the payment processor.
4. The Handbid app will add you as a bidder. You will be checked in as a bidder from the Handbid iPad app using the PADDLE feature that is available in the top menu on the iPad. To do this, go to your item

view for your auction. Select the Paddle icon at the top of the screen. A text message with the users paddle number will be sent to the bidder as the account has been created.

5. Again, the first step is to select the CREATE ACCOUNT button enter your first name, last name, email, and cell phone.
6. Log into the app with the same bidder account that has been enabled for you.

Finally, explore the event app and ENJOY our Parish Country Fair Online Bidding! A lot of great items to find!
