




From the desk and Zoom classes of Mrs. Courtney Abruzzo on 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Art Vocation Posters

#### 3rd Grade: Social Studies: Biography Book Report by Mrs. Pamela Wardle

In 3rd grade, students were tasked with researching a famous person of their choice. They had to read a biography on that person that was over 75 pages long. They then dressed up as that person and reported as that person over Zoom. They gave their life story and what they were famous for. Then, other students asked them hard hitting questions that maybe were not answered in their report. Some of our famous guests included: Amelia Eirheart, Albert Einstein, Julia Child, Florence Nightingale, Nicola Tesla, and Abe Moss! #### Resource Specialist's Report for Grades K-3 by Mrs. Teresa Nelson

Kindergarten is working on Alphabetic Principle and phonics. (Extra support provided through "Heidisongs", EDMARK "Bailey's Book House", Pinkcat games.com, and Epic.) First Grade is working on reading comprehension, main idea, and first grade sight word recognition. (Additional support is provided through EDMARK "Bailey's Book House", Reading A-Z, Minteatery.com, Dolch SIght Words, Pincatgames.com, and The Teaching Treehouse). Second Grade focus is on sight word recognition Dolch, reading fluency, reading comprehension, contractions, main idea and key details. (Extra support provided through SISD Reading First, EDMARK "Bailey's Book House", Tobin reading comprehension and fluency, and Pinkcat.com). Third grade focus is paragraph writing using first, next, then and last, reading fluency, influences, and reading comprehension. (Extra support provided through Annie Moffit.com, KerryLutz.com, InspireMeASAP.com, PinkCat and Epic.com).

## Resource Specialist's Report for Grades 4th through 8th by Mrs. Ashley Liberda

All is going well with 4th through 8th. Mrs. Liberda makes certain to communicate with the Homeroom Teachers every week (usually Friday) updating them on how each child is performing. She provides them both with each student's weekly percentage, as well as their overall performance for all assignments submitted. Prior to Thanksgiving break, she emailed each parent in the program a report of how their child is doing, what his/her strengths are, what areas he/she can improve upon, and a detailed list of exactly where the child struggles (citing textual evidence, drawing conclusions, identifying the main idea, etc.). The parents were appreciative of such communication. A few parents from this program also reached out asking what other materials can be purchased to help their child with comprehension strategies.

#### Advanced Learner's Program Report by Mr. Clarence Clark

Teachers were reminded to add their information to the Google doc. A form letter was provided to teachers for possible communication with parents. Fourth and Fifth Grade students have begun or soon will begin Move-Up Math (MUM). Younger students and their teachers have also been in communication about possible participation. Dr. Suelto expressed the view that often students take great pride in being invited to move-up. Ms. Huntley also stressed the advantage of students not being graded and allowed to be exposed to higher level Math.

On Wednesday, December 2nd, a parent orientation session was held and on Friday, December 4th, the first meeting was held with the ALA students.
