
A Victory Announcement from Athletic Director Teresa Nelson

Congratulations to our HFGS Bulldog Cheer Teams. The SHARP Cheer International Virtual performance award ceremony presented the following awards:



Some facts from our Superintendent Paul Escala on his memo dated 5/9/2021

Catholic Schools are already showing strong signs that our system is emerging from the pandemic stronger, smarter, and poised... The following are a few significant facts:

- Our Schools are open Over 90% of our TK-12 schools are open for in-person instruction and well over half of our high schoolers are back on-campus.
- Our Staff is vaccinated Over 95% of our schools are reporting 70%-100% of personnel are fully vaccinated.
- Students are growing academically Over 62% of students grew between 2.4% to 7.7% in reading and math this year.

Since the start of the pandemic, all of you - our pastors, school leaders, teachers, staff, and families have worked tirelessly to support our students, demonstrating unwavering resilience. The work you have done to safely reopen our schools and keep them open is unmatched by any other system of schools in California. We look forward to advancing our goal of providing a quality Catholic education to the children of all families...
