- 1. Costumes worn should fit the Catholic school environment.
- 2. Ingenuity is encouraged to create a favorite and appropriate book character costume.
- 3. No blood, no weapons (no sword, no gun, no big hammer is to be brought to school.)
- 4. No costumes that are flimsy, immodest, or provocative are allowed.
- 5. No demonic characters.
- 6. Costumes must be worn comfortably during the parade. It should not be too heavy to wear or carry.
- 7. All students, siblings, parents, staff, and faculty are invited to come in their own costumes during the morning parade.
- 8. Students change out of their costumes and wear their regular uniform after the repeat of their PCF class performance on stage.
- 9. Candies and little toys received as treats are to be enjoyed at home.
