Science Contest 2024

Exciting news! Our upcoming Science Contest offers every student and grade level a chance to participate. Some classes have already received guidelines, which are due by Friday, January 19. Here are the engaging topics our students will explore. Enjoy the journey of learning Science and uncovering fascinating facts and processes!

Science Contest Guidelines - led by our Science teachers, Dr. Kiladjian, and Mrs. Soliman

TK - Four Seasons of the Year
Kindergarten: Diorama of Animal Habitat
1st Grade: Comparing Seasons with a plant or animal
2nd Grade: Plant Research Project
3rd Grade: Scientific Process with a visual representation of an experiment.
4th Grade: Individual Science Experiment or Investigation using the Scientific Method. Findings will be displayed visually.
5th Grade: Cells Unit test covering cell structure and organelles, DNA, plant and animal cells, prokaryotes and eukaryotes, homeostasis, cell division, mitosis, and meiosis.
6th Grade: Construct a rain cycle demonstrating condensation, precipitation, evaporation, and collection, making salt water safe to drink.
7th Grade: DNA model
8th Grade: Design a vessel that stays afloat.
Projects are due a week before the end of the second quarter.
